Original sign painted on an ice house near the site at Lakshore. This is the only remaining evidence that the Bayou Caddy was once in Lakeshore.

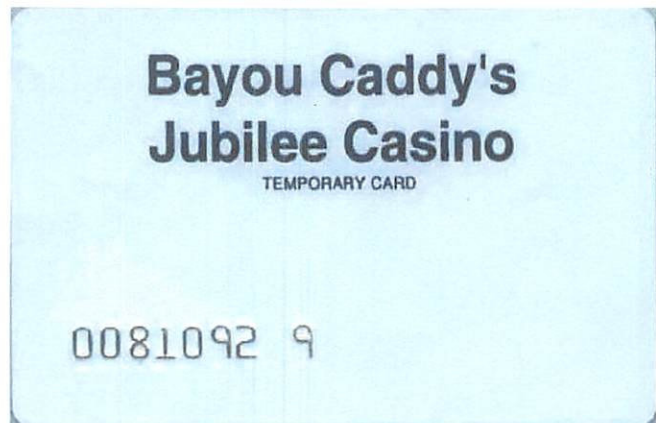

It opened in Greenville as the Jubilee on November 17, 1995.
