

MHOON LANDING, MS.

In 1990 the Mississippi legislature legalized gaming in the state and in 1991 Mhoon Landing (near Tunica) was chosen as a site to begin the adventure.

On October 19, 1992 the Splash Casino opened, followed on September 18, 1993 by the Lady Luck Casino, and December 6, 1993 Bally's Casino and The President Casino opened. The Splash Casino welcomed its 3 millionth visitor on September 5, 1994.

Because of the success of gaming in Tunica, which is closer to Memphis, the Splash closed its doors on May 24, 1995. The Lady Luck closed on April 4, 1994, The President on July 8, 1994 and Bally's on February 9, 1995.




